

Praying for Revive '17

At *Revive Our Hearts*, we're busy making the final arrangements for Revive '17 with great anticipation. We're fairly certain you're busy, too—preparing to step away from the normal routine for a couple of days. As we get ready, let's not overlook preparing our hearts through prayer.

Will you join us over the next two weeks as we lift our voices asking God to work in a powerful way? Let's bow our hearts together . . .

Friday, September 15 **Beauty Secrets of Titus 2**

Ponder Titus 2:10: "That in everything they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior."

Prayer Points:

- Ask the Lord to prepare your heart to hear from Him during Revive '17. Pray for a fresh vision of how to fulfill your Titus 2 calling to live out the transforming power of the gospel—together in community.
- Pray that the women attending the conference and participating through the Livestream will live intentional lives that grow more beautiful day by day as the gospel adorns our lives.

Saturday, September 16 **The "What" and the "Now What"**

Ponder Titus 2:1: "Teach what accords with sound doctrine."

Prayer Points:

- Pray that your life will be shaped by the sound doctrine of God's Word. Ask the Father for wisdom to discern truth from error and for protection from the deception of false teaching.
- Pray for our conference speakers as they finalize their messages: Nancy DeMoss Wolgemuth, Mary Kassian, Dannah Gresh, Susan Hunt, Damaris Carbaugh, Robyn McKelvy, and Betsy Gomez. May their words make much of God and display the loveliness of Jesus Christ.

Sunday, September 17 **Aging Beautifully—At All Ages**

Ponder Titus 2:2–3: "Older men are to be . . . Older women likewise."

Prayer Points:

- Pray that no matter what your age, your life will be worthy of emulating. Pray we will allow the Lord to refine us so that we radiate the glow of His workmanship.
- Ask the Lord for many more women to hear about the Revive '17 Livestream and that the Spirit would stir their hearts to participate.

Monday, September 18 **Teaching and Learning—Life-to-Life**

Ponder Titus 2:3–4: “Teach what is good, and so train the young women.”

Prayer Points:

- Pray that the treasures of God’s truth received from seasoned spiritual sisters will be passed down through you. Even though none of our lives are perfect, ask Jesus to make you fruitful right where you are now.
- Pray that the soil of our hearts will be fertile so the seeds of truth sown throughout the conference will produce an abundant harvest after it ends.

Tuesday, September 19 **Living in Sacred Service**

Ponder Titus 2:3: “Reverent in behavior.”

Prayer Points:

- Pray we will become women who pursue reverence because God is worthy of our wholehearted devotion and obedience. May pleasing Him be our most delightful pursuit.
- Lift up Josh Davis as he leads us to worship with one voice to glorify God. Pray that the twenty-eight countries and fifty states represented at Revive ’17 will be unified under the banner of Jesus Christ.

Wednesday, September 20 **Abstaining from Slander**

Ponder Titus 2:3: “Not slanderers.”

Prayer Points:

- With God’s help, pray that we’ll use our tongues to build up those around us rather than tearing them down. Pray that each of us will contribute to the peace and unity of the Spirit within our homes and churches.
- Ask God to quickly break down barriers between women so each one feels welcomed, comfortable, and at home with one another. Pray the love of Christ will flow among us.

Thursday, September 21 **Experiencing Freedom from Bondage**

Ponder Titus 2:3: “Not . . . slaves to much wine.”

Prayer Points:

- Pray that women will be liberated from every earthly enslavement to become wholehearted, grateful adoring slaves of Jesus Christ. May we each experience the joy, freedom, and sweet worship that overflow from being wholly His.
- Pray that each woman will have a personal encounter with the Lord during the weekend. Pray that we will be ready to take practical steps of obedience turning from sin to repentance and freedom.

Friday, September 22 **Developing Self Control**

Ponder Titus 2:5: “To be self-controlled.”

Prayer Points:

- Pray your mind will be renewed with right thinking that leads to right behavior. Pray each of us will practice Spirit-produced, Word-empowered self-control that frees us to love and serve God and others.
- Pray the *Revive Our Hearts* staff and technicians serving behind the scenes will be alert and proficient in their roles. Ask God to reign supreme—protecting from any unnecessary distractions or interruptions.

Saturday, September 23 Pursuing Holiness in an Unholy World**Ponder** Titus 2:5: “To be . . . pure.”**Prayer Points:**

- Pray that your life will mirror God’s holiness to our world. Through the grace and power of the Holy Spirit, may we be victorious over every temptation to live in personal, practical purity.
- Fervently pray for an outpouring of revival in each heart, home, church, and community where we live.

Sunday, September 24 Cultivating a Heart for Home**Ponder** Titus 2:5: “To be . . . working at home.”**Prayer Points:**

- Pray for God to give you a heart for your home and that you will use hospitality as a means to put the gospel and the grace of God on display.
- Pray for the creative gifts of dramatic artist Carol Anderson Shores to communicate the transforming power of the gospel during the conference.

Monday, September 25 Training Our Hearts for Relationship**Ponder** Titus 2:4: “To love their husbands.”**Prayer Points:**

- Boldly intercede for marriages in need of renewal and restoration. Pray for all Christian marriages to be strengthened to display the covenant-keeping faithfulness of God.
- Pray your heart will be tender and receptive to the Holy Spirit as you hear each message. Pray we’ll seize the freedom to meet with the Lord privately and to reach out for prayer as He prompts.

Tuesday, September 26 Discovering the Strength and Beauty of Submission**Ponder** Titus 2:5: “To be . . . submissive to their own husbands.”**Prayer Points:**

- Humbly pray to embrace God-ordained authority as a gracious gift to be used for His glory. May our eyes be opened to the privilege women have to represent the mystery and beauty of the Son’s submission to the Father.

- Intercede with prayers for spiritual protection and physical safety for Nancy DeMoss Wolgemuth and the entire Revive '17 speaker team. Ask for God's hand and anointing to be upon them moment by moment.

Wednesday, September 27 Embracing the Gift of Motherhood

Ponder Titus 2:4: "To love their . . . children."

Prayer Points:

- Pray that mothers (grandmothers, godmothers, and aunts, too!) will be invigorated in our calling to be nurturers of physical and spiritual life. Ask God—even now—to meet you in your places of deep need.
- Intercede for the protection and safety over our loved ones while we are away from home.

Thursday, September 28 Showing a Deeper Kind of Kindness

Ponder Titus 2:5: "To be . . . kind."

Prayer Points:

- Pray you'll be a vessel of grace and help to people in need. Ask Jesus for eyes of compassion to see people as He does. May our small sacrifices made in His name reflect the goodness and kindness of our heavenly Father.
- Lift up the staff at the convention center and hotels who are handling the conference logistics. Pray that the kindness and love of the Father will shine through us drawing them to Christ.
